**DESCRIPTION:**

Since the original distribution of land by the Mormon Church was not valid under federal law, Congressional and Territorial legislation were necessary to establish federally recognized ownership. In March 1867, Congress passed "An Act for the Relief of the Inhabitants of Cities and Towns upon the Public Lands" (Statutes at Large, Treaties, and Proclamations, of the United States of America, vol. 14, chap. 177). This act provided that officials of incorporated towns should enter town site lands at the land office and purchase them for the benefit of all inhabitants. Pursuant to this law, the Territorial Legislature established further regulations (Compiled Laws of Utah, 1876. Chap 4). Within 30 days after making the entry, the mayor was required to give public notice and advertise the land he had entered. Each person claiming to be a rightful owner of any part of this land was required to present a claim to the probate court, which was to determine the validity of each claim. These records are declaratory statements issued by the Sanpete County Probate Court stating ownership of specific lots.

**DESCRIPTION:**

In 1852, the Utah Territorial Legislature provided that the Probate Court should have jurisdiction not only in estate and guardianship matters, but original jurisdiction in civil, criminal, and chancery cases. In 1874, the federal Poland Act revoked the jurisdiction of the Probate Court over all but divorce and probate cases. This series includes those cases handled by the Probate Court which are divorce cases. In 1887, the federal Edmunds-Tucker act revoked Probate Court jurisdiction in divorce cases.

Generally, case files include a number of discrete documents. These documents may include an initiating petition, summons and subpoenas issued to the parties in the case and to witnesses, bonds, exhibits, statements of fees, and other documents created and filed with the Court during the process of the trial action. Civil cases may include affidavits of publication of summons in those cases where the defendant was not served personally, as well as decrees detailing the disposition of the case.

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Sanpete County Probate Court recorded the standard actions taken in probate matters in three separate bound volumes: Guardians Record, Will Record, and Administrator's Record. In each book preprinted forms were filled out to describe the actions taken. Estate settlements for persons who died intestate were recorded in Book 1, Administrator's Record. Guardianship cases were recorded in Book 2, Guardian's Record. And estate settlements for persons whose estates were probated according to the terms of a will were recorded in Book 3, Will Record. Standardized forms describe the basic orders, decrees, oaths and letters associated with the settlement of the estate or guardianship appointment. Book 3, Will Record includes the probate of wills for only eight individuals: Niels C. Jensen, Ole P. Larsen, Peter Hansen, John E. Metcalf, Soren C. Hansen, and Christopher Bernard Hansen. The Guardianship and Administrator Record Books contain a few more records.
