They are preprinted books divided into criminal and civil sections with an alphabetical index by defendants and plaintiffs surnames. There are loose papers (correspondence, complaints, affidavits, citations) attached to individual cases. The books include the names of the judge, plaintiff(s), defendant(s), charge, date, summary of case, decision, fines, and attorney fees.
