It includes date, warrant number, payments to teachers (divided by male and female); to whom issued; school supplies; building sites, building rent, finishings and apparatus; library books, free textbooks; repairs and improvements; current expenses; compensations of trustees and board members; payment to janitors; payment of matured bonds; payment of interest on bonds; compensation of census enumerators, truant officers and clerical assistants; salary of supervisors and principals; sinking fund investments and investments; overdrafts; other disbursements; and remarks.
