The correspondence marks the communications that flowed between the Committee members (who served on a volunteer basis), the Committee's paid research director, schools and universities throughout Utah, as well as national educational bodies and expert individuals that were consulted. Some administrative records are also included indicating budgetary constraints and details of office organization.
